- Each bible reading usually has a link to the Value being addressed in collective worship or is relevant to the season or festival.
- Every week, the children should be given an opportunity to read (or be read) the passage from their Children's Bible in class.
- Take opportunities to discuss with the children how the story makes them feel, what
 message we can take from the story and how it could be relevant to our lives today –
 and how it and/or the Christian Value can help us to

21 st March	Forgiveness/Lent	'The Little Man in the Tree' p305. (Luke 19) Turning over a
		new leaf. Jesus forgives tax collector Zacchaeus who changes
		his ways.

28 th March	Forgiveness/Lent/Easter*	'The Weeping Women', 'Jesus on the Cross' (p343), 'The Last
		Moments' (p344) and 'The Death of Jesus' (p346).
		Some of the Easter Story. Jesus forgives the people who
		crucify him. The Cross has become a Christian symbol for
		forgiveness – forgiveness for the sins of the world.
4 th April	Forgiveness	The story of the resurrection: 'The Burial' p350, 'Guards at
	/Lent/ Easter*	the Tomb' p 353, 'An Empty Tomb' p354. (You could also
		read on to 'Mary Magdalene Sees Jesus' p356)

^{*}Easter: In addition to the specific readings here for the last 2 weeks of term, it's a good opportunity for the children to open their Bibles to read more passages relating to the Easter Story. You may find other passages that relate to your year group's Easter RE learning.
