### Understanding the world

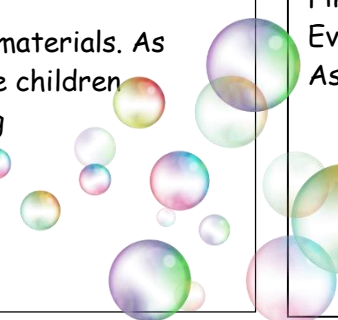
*People and Communities*
