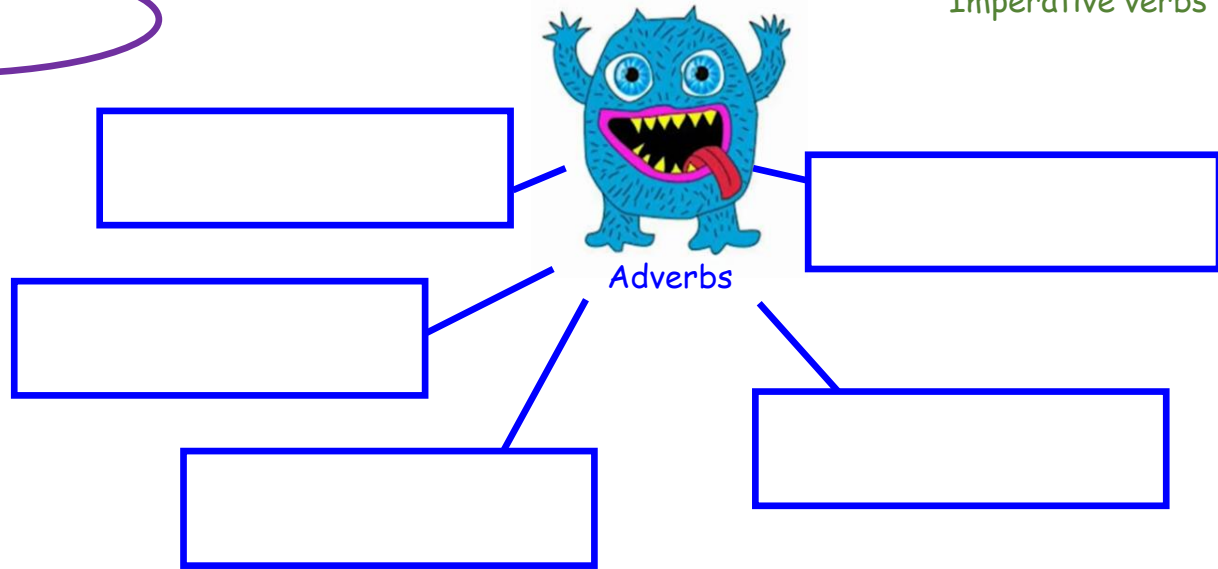
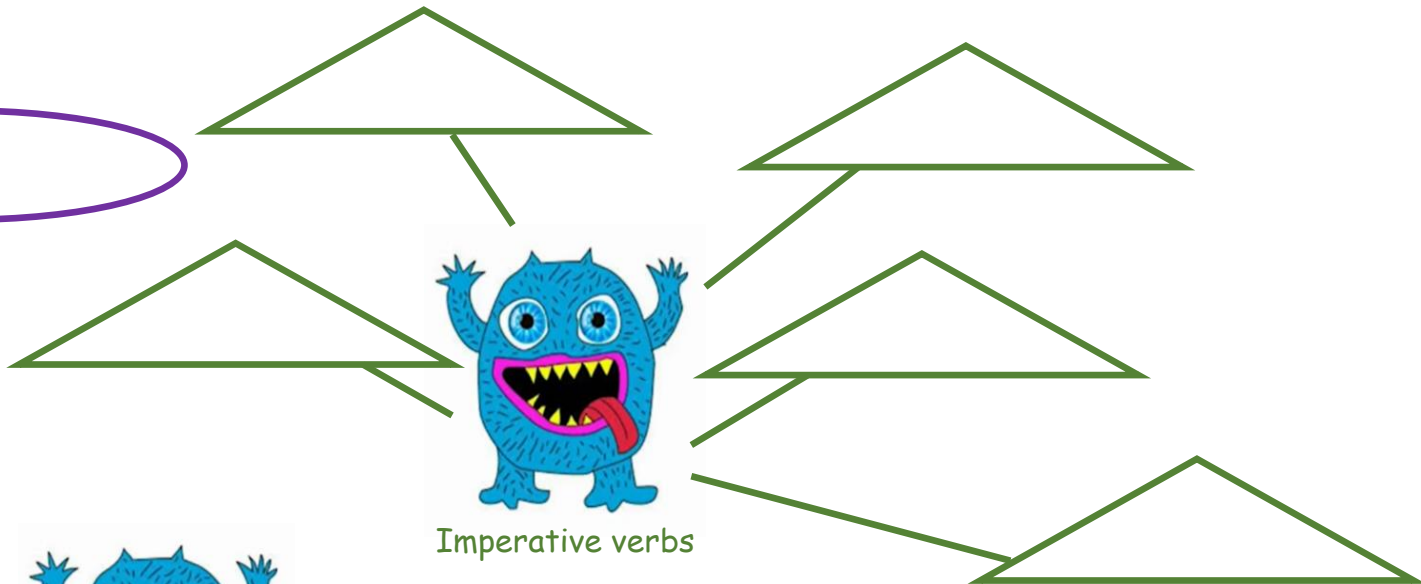
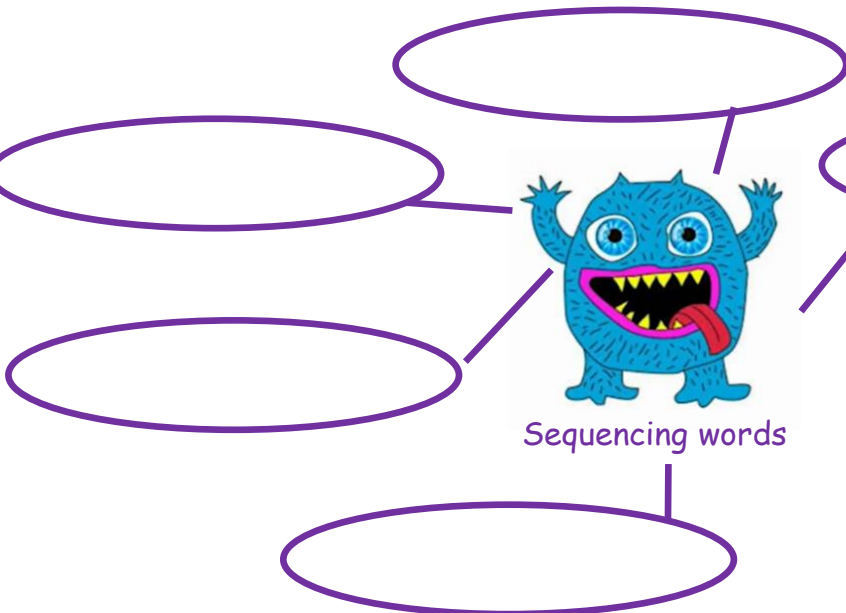


Literacy Friday 26th February - generating vocabulary for instruction writing.
