

## **TEAMS FREE DAY**

To celebrate World Book Day, we have created an exciting selection of book themed activities for you to choose from.

You MUST listen to chapters 12 and 13 of Beetle Boy at some point during the day.

You must select at least three of the book based activities in the grid below to complete. If you would like to complete more, that would be wonderful!

Build a reading den in your house and then snuggle up to read a good book.	Record yourself reading a story book. You could do an audio recording to make an audio book like Mr O's recordings of Beetle boy. (You may just want to read the first chapter of your chosen book). Or you could film yourself reading a book like in Jackanory https://www.bbc.co.uk/programmes/p019gl16	Create your own book. It could be a story book, a poetry book or a non-fiction book about a topic that fascinates you.	Design an advert for a book that you love.	Dress up as a character from a book.
Design your dream classroom book corner. What books would it include? How should it be organised? How could it be decorated?	Extreme reading challenge – take a selfie of you reading in unusual places and positions. Make sure you choose safe places to read and that your photos are suitable to share at school!	Design a book trailer to encourage other people to read a book that you love.  Have a look at the book trailer for The One and Only Ivan for inspiration.  https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=UtPdqV2crQ0	Write a list of your personal top ten books to read before you finish primary school. You never know, we may use these lists to help us when we order new books for the book corner!	Create a quiz about your favourite book, author or character. Perhaps we can share some of these quizzes when we return to school!
Play a game of book based charades with your family.	Share a story with a sibling or parent.	Make an origami corner bookmark following this tutorial.  https://www.youtube.com/watch ?v=tXqBHW7TPoA	Complete the World Book Day scavenger hunt. You will find a copy of this saved in Teams –Files.	Decorate a potato as a character from a book.
