We have two classes for each year group. Our Year 1 classes are called Tawny Owls and Elf Owls

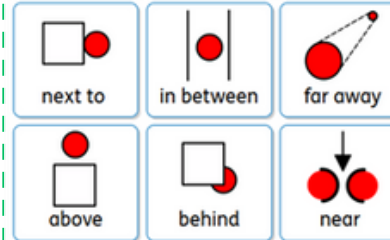


This is our school logo. Our school is named after Yatton which is a place.
