



## September Organisation

If we are in the same position nationally and there are no further lockdowns in place when we start in September (fingers crossed) this will be the organisation for the school. If there are any changes to this, you will be informed via ParentPay and it will be on our website by the Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September.

**COVID SAFE** - The following measures will still be in place in September:

- Hand and respiratory hygiene
- Ventilation
- Arrangements if a child develop symptoms in school
- Additional cleaning
- LFT testing of staff in September (this may continue we don't know yet.)
- Parents and staff can continue to wear masks / use screen if they wish. This will be personal choice and we as a community will respect that.
