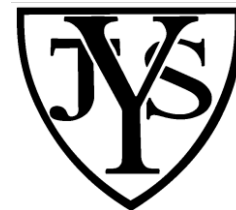




# Yatton Schools Newsletter

## 2nd Place for Yatton Junior Mini Marathon runners

Back in September 2023 Yatton Junior School held the annual Mini Marathon at Hangstones, where every student in the Junior school took part running approximately 1 mile.

The fastest five girls and boys in year 5 and 6 earned themselves a place at the "Primary Cross Country event" which took place at Bristol Grammar Sports Ground, Failand in October.

Out of the 20 Yatton Junior athletes, 5 of them (Darcey T, Charlie C & Seb K in Year 5 and Eva and Sam in Year 6) came in the top 12, which secured them a place at the finals in the "Inter area primary cross country event" which took place at Ashton Court Secondary School, Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> March.

On the day we had Darcey, Charlie and Eva representing both Yatton Junior School and North Somerset, who also looked very smart in the new kit supplied by YSA.



Darcey and Charlie ran in the year 5 group and Eva the year 6 group, all running fantastically well and earning points for North Somerset to come 2nd place overall. It was a brilliant day with over 240 participants taking place.

## Aspens Price Increase

Our catering provider, Aspens, are committed to providing nutritious menus, catering for a wide range of dietary preferences while also ensuring good value for money and using locally sourced produce. However, after two years of frozen prices we have had to take the difficult decision to increase the cost of our school meals. From 1st April 2024, the cost of a school meal will increase to £2.65. The new price reflects a necessary adjustment to cover continued high food inflation and increasing operating costs.

Aspens wish to reassure you that this decision was made after careful consideration, and we understand the financial concerns this may raise for some families.

As a reminder, all children in Reception, Year 1, or Year 2, are entitled to Universal Free School Meals. If your child is in Years 3-6 in primary school or Years 7-13 in secondary school and your circumstances have changed, you may be entitled to free school meals. If you are unable to complete the form online, please visit the school office, and a member of our office team will provide you with the necessary support. Please be assured that your application will be treated with the utmost confidentiality, and it will not affect any other benefits you may be receiving.

## Carnival Updates:

This year's Carnival theme has been confirmed as THE OLYMPICS. They are being held in Paris this year so we thought it would be a good way for everyone to get involved 😊 There are so many things that you can dress up as - athletes, flags, or even the Olympic torch so get your thinking caps on!!

## Sponsorship –

We will be holding the annual Summer Carnival on Saturday 15th June, which involves a procession of pupils from Yatton Schools and the local preschools down the High Street and will end up in Hangstones Field for an afternoon of entertainment, fun, workshops, music, BBQ, singing and dancing. It is a brilliant annual event, and last year we raised over £10,500 of essential funds for Yatton Infant and Junior schools. Given the cost of living crisis and government budget cuts, this money is used by the school for both essential resources and enhanced learning opportunities for the children. In the past few years' money raised by YSA has been spent on:

- Building an ICT suite, where the children can learn computer skills;
- Building a food technology kitchen, where children can learn about the importance of nutrition and have cookery lessons;
- Paying for coaches so the children can go on fun educational day trips;
- Technology for SEND pupils;
- Creating a gardening space in both schools, where the children can have hands-on learning experiences to understand the nature lifecycle and how to grow fruit and vegetables.

The summer carnival is a FREE community event, therefore we try our best to keep costs as low as possible in order to raise as much as possible for the schools. The only way that we can achieve this is to have local businesses provide sponsorship for the event.

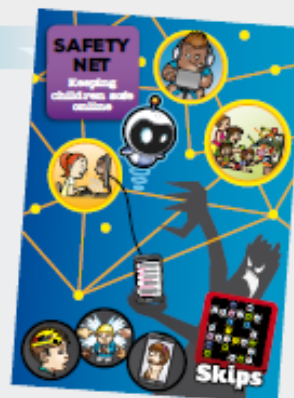

They feel they can't turn to parents or a trusted adult for support as they fear they may get in trouble or have their devices taken away from them. It can carry on all day, all evening and all weekend for the world to see, causing a lot of emotional stress to the victim and their family.
